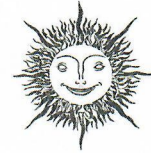

In Nicosia

The bus will depart from the roundabout of Marcou Drakou (near our Holy Cross Church) at 09:45 hrs.

The Holy Mass and blessing of tombs at the new cemetery at Tseri will be at 3.00 p.m

In Limassol the Holy Mass and blessing of tombs at the Latin cemetery at Griva Dighenis Street (near the Fire Station) it take place at 3.30 p.m

In Larnaca the Holy mass and blessing of the tombs will be at 3.00 p.m

In Paphos Holy Mass will be celebrated at the Church of St. Kyriaki at 9.00 am and 12.00 midday, the blessing of the tombs will take place at the Mesa Chorio cemetery at 4.00 pm and there will also be a Holy Mass at the Church of St. Dimitriou at Polis Chrysochou at 6.00 pm

2. The Latin Centre

On 12 October H.E. the President of the Republic, Mr Nicos Anastasiades inaugurated this new cultural and exhibition centre.
